

Jersey Flood Statistics

This devastating storm initiated the largest American Red Cross emergency relief effort since the hurricane season of 2005. The chapter's local response represented the primary focus of the total operation. We managed the response for five days when the national disaster resources began to arrive in force. Hundreds of volunteers were deployed from over 40 states.
